LITTLE Sheep

Crochet Pattern





MATERIALS:

2mm crochet hook, gray, blue, green and yellow yarn, sewing needle, stuffing material, scissors.



Little SHEEP is a design toy created by **TheNomadKnot** especially for the **"Farm Friends"** collection.

This toy was crocheted with 100% acrylic yarn.
Using a 2mm crochet hook and light yarn (around 50g), the finished size must be around 11cm.

The stuffing material used in this toy is hypoallergenic polyester.

This pattern is for personal use. Sharing information from this pattern is prohibited. You may sell items made from this pattern, provided credit to The Nomad Knot as the designer. For this pattern we will work the animal starting from the legs and finishing at the head. Let's begin!

LEGS

With the gray yarn:

1 row2 row5sc in magic ring5inc. *Total: 10sts*

3 row 10Bpsc (see image 02)

4 to 6 row 10sc

 Finish the first leg and make the second one. <u>Tip:</u> at the end of each row, count how many stitches you have in total. This will help you to never leave a stitch behind.

- Don't cut the yarn of the second leg;
- Chain one (image 04).



- Connect the two legs by inserting the chain inside one stitch of the first leg.
- Start the row 7.

<u>NOTE:</u> for the row 7 you should make 1SC in the chain, 10SC around the leg, again 1SC in the other side of the chain, 10SC. Having a total of 22 stitches (image 06).




BODY

Change to blue yarn and continue,

7 row 22sc

8 row 3sc, (1sc, 1inc) repeat 4 times, 3sc, (1sc, 1inc) repeat 4

times. Total: 30sts



<u>Tip:</u> use a colorful yarn as a marker in the last stitch of every row. This will help you to keep track of your work and avoid getting lost (image 09).

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From here we start working with PUFF stitches.

9 To 11 row (1PUFF, 1sc) repeat 11 times. Total: 30sts

12 row (1PUFF, 1sc, 1PUFF, 1dec) repeat 6 times. *Total: 24sts* (1PUFF, 1sc, 1PUFF, 1dec) repeat 4 times, (1PUFF,

1sc) repeat 2 times. Total 20sts.

14 row (1PUFF, 1sc) repeat 3 times, 1PUFF, 1dec, (1PUFF,


1sc) repeat 3 times, 1PUFF, 1dec, 1PUFF, 1sc

Total: 18sts

Return to work with only SC stitches;

15 row (1sc, 1dec) repeat 6 times. *Total 12sts*

- Stop here and stuff the body before continuing to row 15.
- Change to gray yarn.



<u>NOTE:</u> Next row, you are going to work in BLSL (see image 16). This means that you will create an inside row that will become the beginning of the neck. At row 17, you will work in the remaining front loop of the row 15 (see image 15):

16 row 12Blosl
17 row Flo(1sc, 1inc) repeat 6 times. *Total: 18sts*18 row (2sc, 1inc) repeat 6 times. *Total: 24sts*19 row (3sc, 1inc) repeat 6 times. *Total: 30sts*20 to 27 row 30sc

28 row (3sc, 1dec) repeat 6 times. *Total: 24sts* 29 row (2sc, 1dec) repeat 6 times. *Total:18sts*

• Finish stuffing the sheep and continue

30 row (1sc, 1dec) repeat 6 times. *Total:12sts*

31 row 6dec total: 6sts

Cut the yarn and fast off. Hide the remaining yarn inside the toy



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ARMS

1 row2 row5sc in a magic ring5inc. *Total 10sts*

3 to 5 row 10sc

6 row 5dec. *Total 5tst*

7 row 5sc

• Cut the yarn, fasten off and make another one.

Do not stuff the arms.



EARS

1 row 6sc in a magic ring 2 row 6inc *total: 12sts*

3 row 12sc


- Cut the yarn, fasten off and make another one
- For inside the ears, with gray, make 6SC in a magic ring, finish with an SL.
- Cut yarn, fasten off and make another one.
- Sue the gray detail inside the middle of blue detail.



OVER HEAD

1 row 6sc in magic ring
2 row 6inc(1PUFF, 1sc) Total: 12sts (6puff+6sc)
3 row (1PUFF, 1inc) repeat 6 times. Total: 18sts (6puff+12sc)
4 row (1PUFF, 1sc, 1inc(1PUFF, 1sc)) repeat 6 times. Total: 24sts
5 row (1PUFF, 1sc, 1PUFF, 1inc) repeat 6 times. Total: 30sts
6 row 30sc


Cut the yarn leaving 30cm to sew, and fasten off



BAG


1 row 6sc in magic ring 2 row 6inc. *Total: 12tst*

- Finish and make another one.
- Attach one to another making 7SL along the circle (the 3 remaining sts will be the opening of the bag).
- Chain 30 and finish connecting on the other side of the bag



LEAVES

- Chain 6,
- Jump the first chain and make 5sc.
- Chain 6 inside the first st and return making sc in each of the chains;
- Make one sl in the second st;
- Chain 4 inside the third st and return making 1sc in each of the chains.
- Make sl inside the fourth st.
- Chain 5 inside the fifth st and return making 1sc in each of the chains.
- Finish and attach inside the bag.



ASSEMBLY




- 1. Use pins to fasten the body parts of the toy in a way that looks symmetrical to you.
- Sew the arms at row 14 of the toy
- 3. Sew the ears at row 5 of the overhead.
- 4. Place the overhead in the central part of the top of the head. Sewing here is not needed but I think it looks nicer when you do it.



EYES

- 1. Use pins to help you to find the perfect spot for the eyes.
- 2. Place them at row 22 with 2 stitches in between them.





For most of my projects I prefer to embroider the eyes then the plastic safety ones.

First, I start making horizontal lines respecting some imaginary contour of the eyes. Then, I make vertical lines to finish filling empty gaps. I finalize outlining the shape I just made. And that's it!





